- Mountain or hybrid bike is really needed for some sections of gravel and dirt road. On request, some bitumen road alternative routes can be provided for road bikes, but trail will not be marked.
- Rutherglen is flat country with a combination of roads, bike paths and dirt roads & tracks.
- There might be one hill at the beginning of the ride—just making the drink at the end more enjoyable.
- There could be a billabong or two so bring your quick-dry pants for a dip if it's hot!
- In the past there has been a back-up vehicle/sag wagon. Any volunteers for driving a car with bike racks or trailor will be gratefully received.
- Again, in the past, those who want to come along but not ride have organised a bus amongst themselves. Tick the box on the rego form if this is your option and we'll put you in touch with other likemindeds. Note this will be an additional cost but has always been a very fun ride!
