



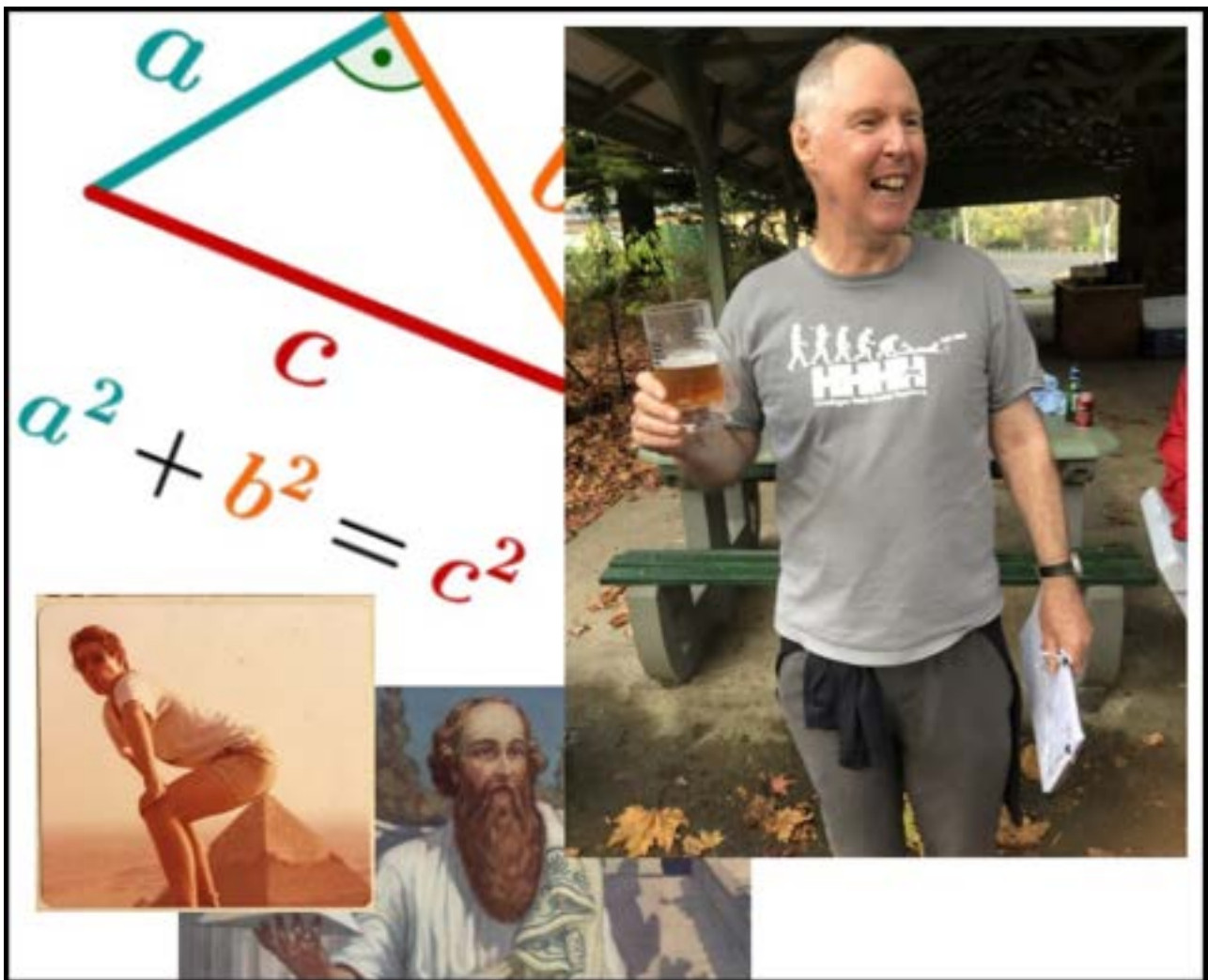

Lakeside Harriette potentially Hinch Wife #6

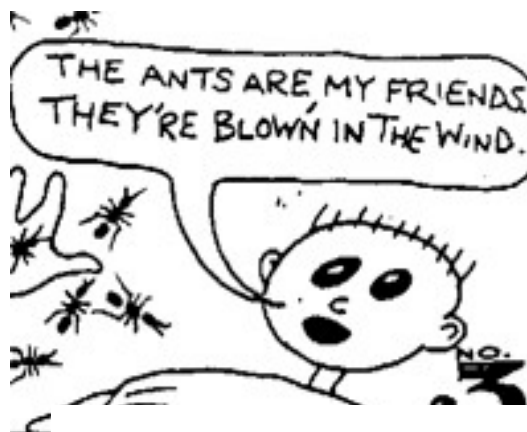

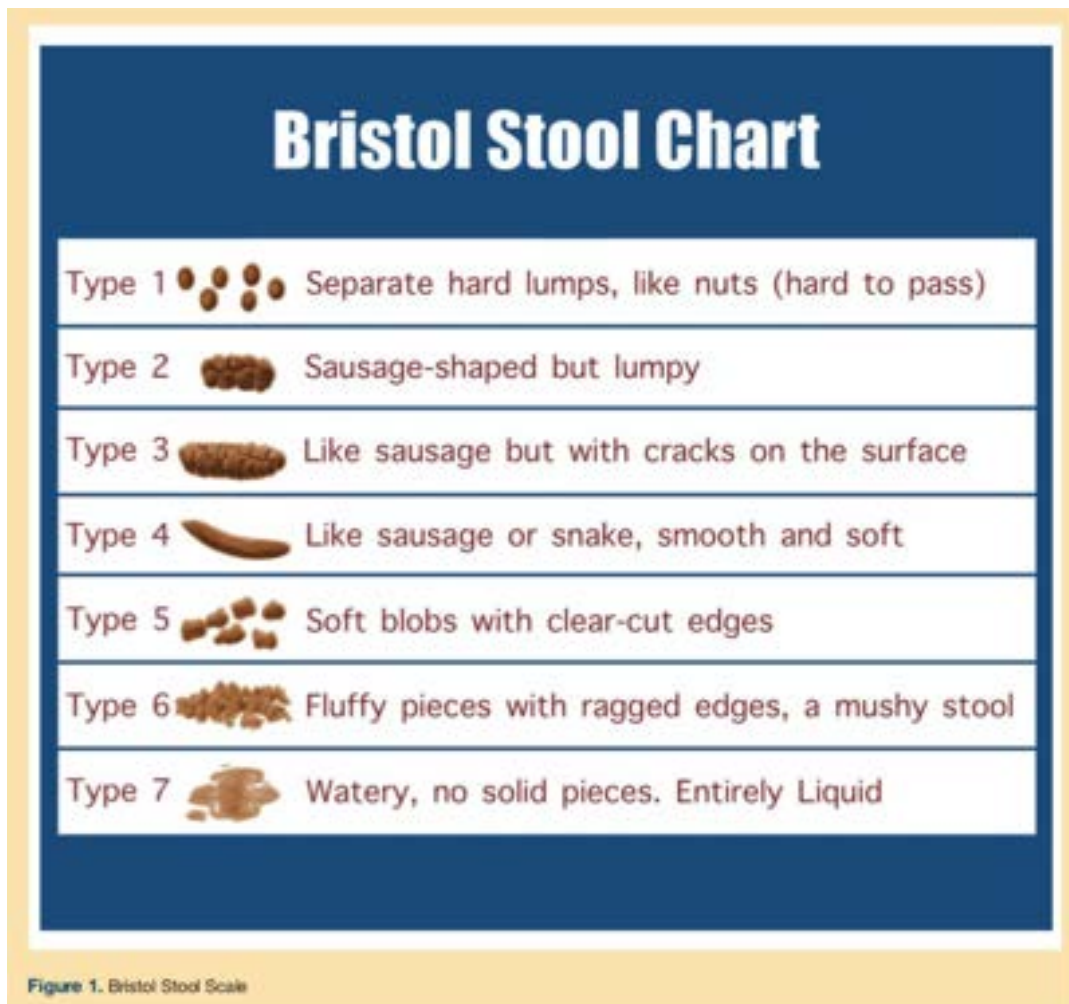
We acknowledge the hares – for without their fine work we would have no reason to run. Particular gratitude to those who volunteered their services without undue coercion.
